Bubbelah Cape

Cozy shoulder warmer worked in the round from the neckline down.

Two strands of fingering weight yarn held together make for a beautiful color and texture blend while creating a soft, drapey fabric.



Sizing and Materials Details

Sizes: One size


Finished measurements: Approximately 26"/65 cm neckline circumference, 68.5"/171 cm bottom circumference, and 15"/38 cm depth when laid flat. See last page for schematic.

Gauge: 14 sts and 20 rounds = 4"/10 cm in circular Stockinette Stitch holding one strand each of Color A and Color B together, blocked, using size needle to obtain gauge.

Needles: US 9 (5.5 mm) 24"/60 cm and 40"/100 cm circular needles or size needed for gauge. US 8 (5 mm) 24"/60 cm circular needles or one size smaller than size needed for gauge. Adjust needle size as necessary to obtain the correct gauge.


Yarn:

Color A: 394 yards of fingering weight (CYCA #1) yarn. Shown in Hand Dyed Yarns by Shaina Bilow "Bounce" (85% Superwash Merino Wool, 15% Nylon; 394 yds/100 g).



Color C (optional, for bottom border): 78 yards of fingering weight (CYCA #1) yarn. Shown in Hand Dyed Yarns by Shaina Bilow "Bounce" (85% Superwash Merino Wool, 15% Nylon; 78 yds/20 g).

Other Materials: 1 stitch marker, tapestry needle.



Elastic Bind Off - knit 2 stitches. * insert the lefthand needle from left to right into the fronts of the two stitches on the right-hand needle. Knit the two stitches together. Knit one stitch; repeat from * until all stitches have been bound off. Fasten off.

inc – increase/increased.

k – knit.

k1tbl – knit one stitch through the back loop. **p** – purl.

st/sts - stitch/stitches.

St-st - Stockinette Stitch: Worked in the round: all rounds are knit.

yo – wrap the yarn over the needle counterclockwise to create an eyelet. One stitch increased.

Special Stitches

K2P2 Ribbing (multiple of 4 sts)

Round 1 (RS): *K2, p2; repeat from * to the end of the round.

Repeat Round 1 for K2P2 Ribbing.





Instructions

Neckline

With size US 8 (5 mm) needles and one strand of Color A held together with one strand of Color B, cast on 96 sts.

Place a marker and, being careful not to twist the sts, join the work in the round.

Work in K2P2 Ribbing until piece measures 4.5"/11 cm from the cast-on edge.

Body

Change to US 9 (5.5 mm) 24"/60 cm needles and knit one round.

Inc Round 1: *K2, yo; repeat from * to the end of the round, 48 sts inc - 144 sts.

Next Round: *K2, k1tbl; repeat from * to the end of the round.

Continue on these 144 sts in St-st for 10 more rounds.

Inc Round 2: *K3, yo; repeat from * to the end of the round, 48 sts inc – 192 sts.

Next Round: *K3, k1tbl; repeat from * to the end of the round.

Change to 40"/100 cm needles.

Continue on these 192 sts in St-St for 10 more rounds.

Inc Round 3: *K4, yo; repeat from * to the end of the round. 48 sts in – 240 sts.

Next Round: *K4, k1tbl; repeat from * to the end of the round.

Continue on these 240 sts in St-st until piece measures 4.5"/11 cm from Inc Round 3.

Optional: Change to two strands of Color 3. Knit one round before beginning Lower Border ribbing, below.

Lower Border

Work 2 rounds in K2P2 Ribbing.

Bind off loosely in ribbing pattern, or use the Elastic Bind Off.

Finishing

Weave in tails. Block to measurements by pinning and then steaming the cape.
